

# Human Amniotic Allograft

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A 58-year-old male with Diabetes Mellitus, non-insulin dependent with peripheral neuropathy, presented to clinic with large plantar pressure ulceration.

The patient failed to heal after repeated serial debridement. He was then treated with surgical intervention with debridement of wound and external application of human amniotic allograft.

The wound was nearly healed at four weeks after graft placement.
